MINUTES

Tuesday, February 24, 2015

Mayor Langford led the Invocation and the Pledge then called the meeting to order.

The Council's only topic of business for this Special Called Meeting is the purchase of property at 951 Hwy. 85 Connector, Brooks, GA. Ellen Walls, Town Manager, presented information about the cost to renovate the Town's current library. Estimates begin at \$130,000 and range upward of \$200,000. After several negotiations with the building's owner/agent, a price of \$224,999.00 was agreed upon and considered reasonable for library relocation.

Mayor Langford asked for public comment of which there was none. Councilman Lewis Harper offered a Motion to approve purchase of said building for library use; Scott Israel offered a Second. The vote was unanimous, all Council Members present in favor of purchase.

A Resolution (2015-001), prepared by Mrs. Walls, was presented and signed by the Town Clerk and all Council Members present.

There being no other business, Lewis Harper made a Motion to adjourn; this was Seconded by Jake Kunz. The Council Members present voted unanimously to adjourn and Mayor Langford closed the meeting.
